

1990 Manitou Days Treasure Hunt

Clue #1:

*Last year you searched on the north side of town;

Explanation:

This clue placed the medallion on the south side of the city.

Clue #2:

*Not a park, but still a public space
Many different sports are played on this place.*

Explanation:

This clue referred to the fact that the medallion was not hidden in a park but at a school where many different sports are played.

Clue #3:

*Do this kind of walking and you'll get a citation
A nearly street is named this – can you guess its location?*

Explanation:

The illegal type of walking is “jay” walking. Jay Lane could be found east of the treasure’s location.

Clue #4:

*A song once was sung by a Fiddler on the Roof
This clue is important – not just a spoof.*

Explanation:

The *Fiddler on the Roof* tune in mention is “Sunrise, Sunset.” The medallion was hidden at Sunrise Middle School.

Clue #5:

*Whether it be tennis, football, softball or hockey
The medallion's location is grassy not rocky.*

Explanation:

This clue named some of the sporting activities found at the middle school and placed the medallion in a grassy area.

Clue #6:

*Once upon a time there were classrooms and pupils to teach
The medallion, from this building, is just out of reach.*

Explanation:

Now closed, the Sunrise Middle School building was very close to the medallion's hiding place.

Clue #7:

*This sport just attracted Minnesota's heart
Now in the medallion hunt is an important part.*

Explanation:

The "sport that just attracted Minnesota's heart" is basketball with the creation of the Minnesota Timberwolves franchise. Further narrowing down the site, the medallion was placed near a basketball court.

Clue #8:

*During late summer you'll see football team pushing these across the field
If you look near the base, a medallion you'll yield!*

Explanation:

This clue revealed the final hiding place of the 1990 medallion, near the base of equipment used for football training.
