Clue #4

Textbooks, baseball, and tennis too

Should give you somewhat of a clue.

Explanation:

"Textbooks" and "baseball" can be found at nearby Bellaire Elementary. "Tennis" is found very near the treasure's site.

Clue #5:

A southern location

Should be your motivation.

Explanation:

This clue put the medallion on the south side of White Bear Lake.

Clue #6:

South of the lake is your bet

Bring your tennis balls and play a set.

Explanation:

Again, hunters are told to focus on the south side of the lake near a tennis court.

Clue #7:

*Old Chevrolets drove this strip
Look mostly low but don't trip!*

Explanation:

This clue placed the medallion on the ground near Cedar Street, which once saw old cars pass along it.
