

1994 Manitou Days Treasure Hunt
Four Seasons Park, White Bear Township

Clue #1:

*Last year in Mahtomedi the treasure was found
This year your search will bring you northbound.
The search is on, the clues are written,
On public property the medallion's been hidden.*

Explanation:

This clue confirmed the medallion's placement on public land and informed hunters to focus on the northern reaches of city/township land.

Clue #2:

*Where Bald Eagle fishermen spend their day
The medallion is hidden not far away.
It's round and it's brass, Burnet logo on top
Very close by is a four-way stop.*

Explanation:

The first line of clue placed the medallion close to Bald Eagle Lake. Four Seasons Park has several sections and a four way stop at the intersection of Park Avenue and Eagle Street.

Clue #3:

*Some eagles fly high
This eagle goes by.
If you're thirsty you outta
Drink some of the water.*

Explanation:

The first half of the clue referred to Eagle Street, which was located just south of the medallion's hiding spot. "Drink some of the water" spoke to a drinking fountain on the other end of the park.

Clue #4:

*If you're tired, sit down, take a swing
WBT 85 it is written, good luck it can bring.
From there, 40 paces, and where can it be found?
Not up in the air, it's down on the ground.*

Explanation:

"Take a swing" referred to a wooden swing in the park with the etching "WBT 85" on it. The medallion was located 40 paces from the swing.
